









The RRB ALP 2024 recruitment process comprises the following stages: CBT 1, then CBT 2, followed by Computer Based Aptitude Test (CBAT), Document Verification, and concluding with a Medical Examination. Moreover, it is important to note that both CBT stages have negative markings, with 1/3rd of the marks deducted for each incorrect answer. However, the third stage has no negative marking and is bilingual, with guestions in both English and Hindi. It is crucial for you to thoroughly understand this pattern before beginning your exam preparation.

## **RRB ALP 2024 Selection Process - CBT 1**

Get ready for the RRB ALP 2024 Selection Process for CBT 1 - your gateway to success in the railway sector! Here's what you need to know:

- RRB ALP CBT 1 will be held in Computer Based Test (CBT) mode.
- You'll tackle a total of 75 multiple-choice questions., with each question carrying 1 mark, resulting in a total of 75 marks.
- There will be a negative marking of 1/3rd mark for each wrong answer.
- You have a tight window of 1 hour to ace the paper.
- The minimum pass percentage will be for UR and EWS 40%, OBC (NCL) 30%, SC 30% and ST 25%.
- The question paper will be divided into 4 sections:
  - Mathematics
  - Mental Ability
  - · General Science
  - · General Awareness

CBT-1 will serve as a screening examination to shortlist eligible candidates for CBT-2, with selection based on their normalized marks and merit. Further, now we are going to discuss CBT-2 in detail which is also an important part of the RRB ALP 2024 Selection Process.

- This section will comprise 100 questions to be completed within the 90-minute time frame.
- 1/3rd mark will be deducted for each wrong answer.
- Furthermore, the qualifying percentage for UR and EWS 40%, OBC (NCL) 30%, SC 30% and ST 25%.
- The questions will cover the following subjects:
  - · General Intelligence & Reasoning
  - Mathematics
  - Basic Science and Engineering

### Part B

- This section consists of 75 questions focused on Trade Tests/Professional Knowledge.
- It's qualifying in nature and requires completion within 60 minutes.
- Furthermore, the qualifying percentage for Part B is 35% for all candidates regardless of category or community.

## **RRB ALP 2024 Selection Process - CBAT**

- You will be shortlisted for the Computer Based Aptitude Test (CBAT) based on the marks obtained in Part A of CBT 2.
- You will need to produce your vision certificate in the prescribed format in its original during the CBAT if you are one of the shortlisted candidates.
- It will be mandatory to clear each section of CBAT separately to qualify.
- During the CBAT, you will find that the test is available only in English and Hindi, and there will be no negative marking.
- You have to secure the minimum total score of 42 marks in each section of the CBAT separately to qualify.

# RRB ALP 2024 Selection Process - Document Verification (DV).

Hence, let us take a look at the Document verification of original certificates for the RRB ALP 2024 selection process:

- Candidates shortlisted for DV will have to produce all their original documents along with two sets of self-attested photocopies at the time of DV.
- Further, these candidates should upload the scanned copies (in true colours) of Photo and Signature before their DV date through the portal https://orims-ir.gov.in/rrbdv.
- All certificates should be either in English or Hindi only. Where certificates are not in English / Hindi, a self-attested translated version in (Hindi/English) should be produced wherever / whenever required. Certificates produced during the DV should be strictly prescribed formats.
- No additional time will be given to the candidates not produce their original certificates on their date of DV and the

# **RRB ALP 2024 Eligibility Criteria**

## Age Limit as on (1/07/2024):

- Are you between 18 and 30 years old? If so, you meet the age requirements to apply.
- Don't worry if you fall outside this range; certain categories enjoy age relaxation as per government regulations.

### Age Relaxation:

Another very important part of this RRB ALP 2024 eligibility criteria is the relaxation provided in it. Age Relaxation in upper age limit / maximum upper age for the following categories/communities in the table below is applicable subject to submission of requisite certificates. we have incorporated a snippet from the official notification below for the same:

1	SC & ST candidates		5 Years
