





# RRB Group D Exam Pattern 2025 - Overview

You are required to submit a single online application to the RRB/RRC of your choice for all the notified posts through the official website

link. The recruitment process will include several stages: the Computer Based Test (CBT), Physical Efficiency Test (PET), Document Verification (DV), and Medical Examination.

The date, time, and venue for each of these activities, as well as any additional stages, will be decided by the RRBs/RRCs and communicated to eligible candidates in due course. Please note that requests for postponing any of these activities or changing the venue, date, or shift will not be entertained under any circumstances.

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## RRB Group D Exam Pattern 2025 - Computer Based **Test**

You must appear for the Computer Based Test on the specified date(s), time, and venue(s) as mentioned in the e-call letter, which you can download from the

#### **RRB**

/RRC websites. Let's now take a look at the RRB Group D exam pattern 2025 for CBT.

The RRB Group D CBT consists of four subjects. The duration of the examination is 90 minutes, with an extended 120minute duration for eligible PwBD candidates accompanied by a Scribe. The exam will feature a total of 100 questions, with 1 mark awarded for each correct answer. Negative marking will apply, with a deduction of 1/3 mark for each incorrect response. Now that you have a thorough understanding of the CBT, let's move on to the next stage of the RRB Group D Exam Pattern 2025 – the Physical Efficiency Test (PET).

## RRB Group D Exam Pattern 2025 - Physical Efficiency **Test**

Based on the merit of candidates in the CBT, candidates will be called for the PET in a ratio of three times the total community-wise vacancies for the posts notified by the RRBs/RRCs. However, the Railways reserve the right to adjust this ratio as needed to ensure an adequate and reasonable number of candidates for all the notified posts. Passing the Physical Efficiency Test (PET) is mandatory and will be qualifying in nature. The criteria for PET are as follows:

If you qualify the PET you will be called for Document Verification based on your merit and preferences.

## RRB Group D Exam Pattern 2025 - Document **Verification**

The documents you need to bring for document verification are listed below:























- Matriculation/High School Examination Certificate or Equivalent Certificate as Proof for Date of Birth and Matriculation Qualification.
- J & K domicile certificate, if applicable.
- NCVT(NTC/NAC) / SCVT Certificate as applicable.
- SC/ST certificate, if applicable.
- OBC-NCL certificate (Not older than one year from the date of document verification)
- · Non creamy layer declaration by OBC-NCL candidates
- Income Certificate for Waiving Examination Fee for Economically Backward Classes
- · Minority Community declarations on Non-judicial Stamp Paper
- Original discharge certificate for Ex-servicemen.
- Self-declaration for Ex-servicemen
- NOC from serving employees with date of appointment from current employer.
- NOC from Serving Defense Personnel (ExSM) with probable date of discharge.
- Gazette notification and/or any Legal document in case of formal change of name
- Receipt of offline payment if made through a challan at the SBI branch or Pay-in-slip at a computerized Post Office.
- · Self-Certification by the Transgender Candidates
- · Certificate of eligibility issued by the Government of India
- Decree of divorce/judicial separation from the competent court of law as applicable and Affidavit stating that the candidate has not remarried.
- Death Certificate of husband in case of widow and Affidavit stating that the candidate has not remarried.
- Ex-SM candidates who secure civil employment after applying for this CEN should give selfdeclaration to the concerned employer about the details of application against this CEN as soon as they join. The acknowledged copy of this declaration along with NOC from the civil employer should be produced during document verification.
- Medical Certificate for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD)
- Income and Asset Certificate to be produced by Economically Weaker Sections

It is important to note that if you pass the Document Verification you will then undergo a Medical Examination.

## RRB Group D Exam Pattern 2025 - Scheme of Examination

- General Science (25 Marks): Covers Physics, Chemistry, and Life Sciences at the 10th-grade (CBSE) level.
- · Mathematics (25 Marks): Topics include the Number System, BODMAS, Decimals, Fractions, LCM, HCF, Ratio and Proportion, Percentages, Mensuration, Time and Work, Time and Distance, Simple and Compound Interest, Profit and Loss, Algebra, Geometry, Trigonometry, Elementary Statistics, Square Roots, Age Calculations, Calendar & Clock, Pipes & Cisterns, etc.
- General Intelligence and Reasoning (30 Marks): Focuses on Analogies, Alphabetical and Number Series, Coding and Decoding, Mathematical Operations, Relationships, Syllogism, Jumbling, Venn Diagrams, Data Interpretation and Sufficiency, Conclusions and Decision Making, Similarities and Differences, Analytical Reasoning, Classification, Directions, and Statement-Based Arguments and Assumptions, etc.
- General Awareness and Current Affairs (20 Marks): Includes current affairs in Science & Technology, Sports, Culture, Notable Personalities, Economics, Politics, and other significant topics.

## RRB Group D Exam Pattern 2025 - Eligibility Criteria

The RRB Group D 2025 eligibility criteria include age limits, educational qualifications, and nationality requirements. These details are crucial to determine your eligibility for the application process. For your convenience, we have provided a detailed explanation of these criteria below.

#### Age Limit:

The eligible age limit for RRB Group D 2025 is between 18 years to 33 years.

### **Educational Qualification:**

- You must have passed 10th grade (OR) hold an ITI certificate from institutions recognized by NCVT/SCVT (OR) possess an equivalent qualification. Or
- You must hold a National Apprenticeship Certificate (NAC) provided by NCVT

### **Nationality:**

- · a citizen of India, or
- · a citizen of Nepal, or
- a subject of Bhutan, or
- a Tibetan refugee who came over to India, before 01.01.1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India, or
- a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African Countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India.

Provided that you belong to the above-mentioned last four categories, you must possess a certificate of eligibility issued by the Government of India. For a more detailed understanding of the
